- Presents excellent organizational skills, demonstrating an affinity for teaching.
- Reveals superior skills in planning and coordinating.
- Demonstrated ability to work collaboratively with Team/Program Leaders.
- Demonstrated computer literacy with word processing, spreadsheet and database skills.
