1. Issues discussed:

- **Mission Website:** participants were adamant in supporting the website and were of the opinion that Mission Leaders should put a little more effort in providing material for sharing on the website.
 - **Educational opportunities:** a) at CHAC annual conference: participants felt that the conference should have one keynote presentation dedicated to Mission each year; b) an advisory committee could be set up to advise CHAC staff re: topic/speaker for Mission keynote presentation.
 - **Mission Facilitator Formation/Educational Seminar:** it was felt that rather than organizing another session CHAC should link up with CHAO to participate in their annual Mission formation seminar. An invitation would be sent out to all Mission Leaders across Canada.
 - **Communication (internal and external) about mission of organization:** It was felt that one of the major challenges in Mission has to do with how well we communicate the Mission internally and externally (i.e. content, method etc.) An educational session where this issue could be addressed by a communication specialist would be welcomed by all.
2. **Survey to be prepared by CHAC:** participants felt strongly that there was the need to survey Mission Leaders/Facilitators across Canada so as to identify issues of interest / educational needs etc.
3. **Networking with Mission Facilitators across Canada:** there was a suggestion that a consent form be forwarded to all Mission facilitators asking them if they would allow name, address, telephone number and email address to be posted on Mission Website so as to encourage more sharing and collaboration.
4. **Value added:** We keep saying that Catholic Healthcare is value added; more reflection is needed on identifying which values we bring to healthcare and how those values are expressed in the day to day life of the organization.
