A Year In Review

Background

On October 19, 1921 St. Joseph's Hospital admitted its first patient. The Sisters of St. Joseph of Toronto established the hospital in response to the healthcare needs of a growing community in Toronto's west end. At the time there were no other hospitals between Bathurst Street and Hamilton. A century later, St. Joseph's Health Centre continues to provide excellent and compassionate care to the west end community.

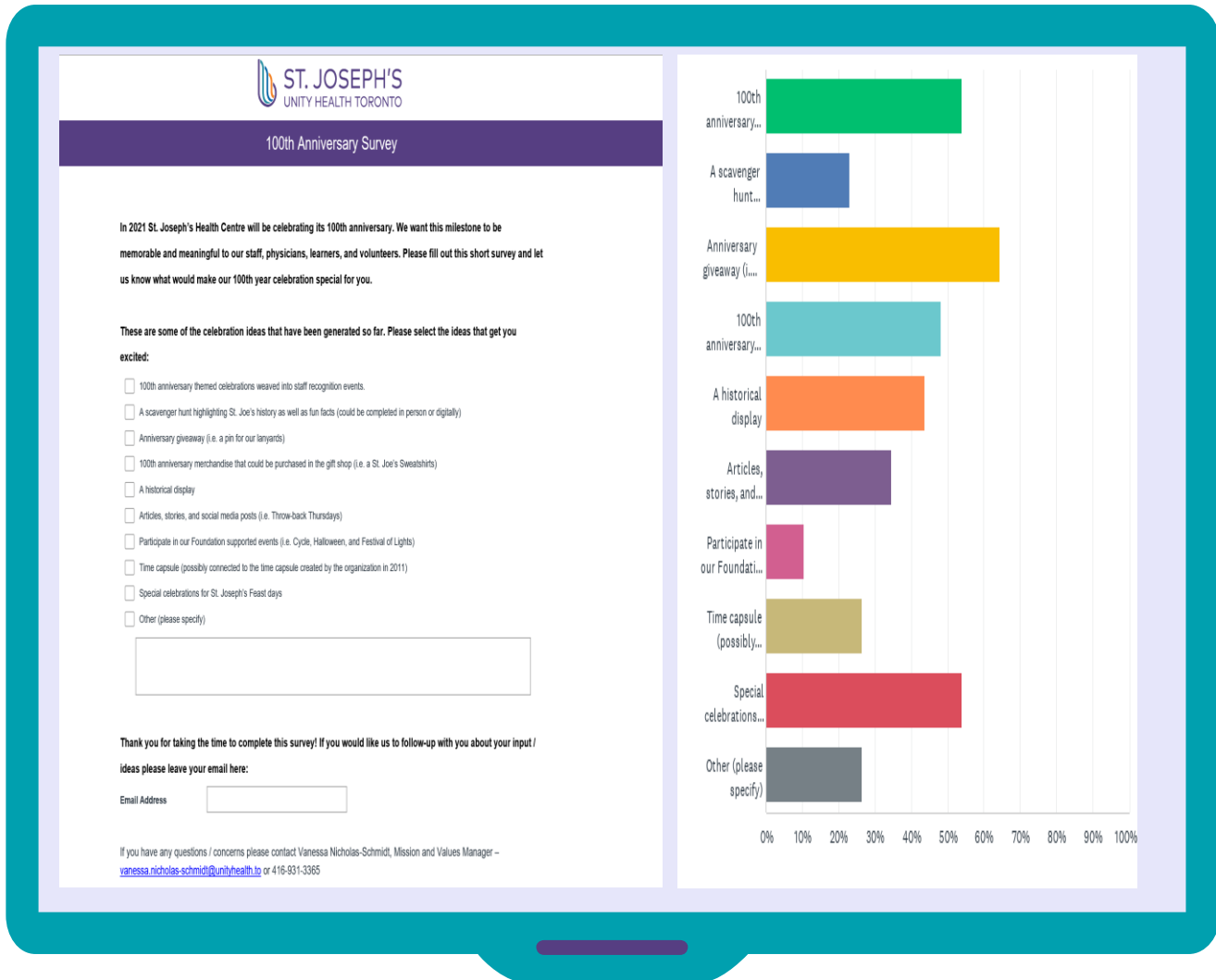
